Dorsal Night Splint

The ISO Preferred Dorsal Night Splint is a foot drop splint, recumbent positioning device designed to hold the foot in an upright position, close to a 90-degree angle, while sleeping, for a gentle steady stretch to the Plantar fascia, Achille's tendon and Calf muscle. The ISO-AN39x provides strong support and pain relief throughout the night. The lightweight, low profile open heel style produces less heat retention during the night. An air bladder located on the top of the foot adds to the patient's comfort. The splint can be worn with or without a sock and fits the right or left foot. The adjustable advanced hook and loop system secures the calf and foot straps, is easy to use and results in an optimum fit.





ISO Preferred Dorsal Night Splint (AN39x) is intended for Plantar fasciitis, Drop foot, Achilles' tendonitis, Heel pain, Arch foot pain.

Application:

1. Unfasten and disengage foot and calf straps.







Check for adequate circulation. Readjust foot and calf straps as needed for a secure and comfortable fit. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN**.

It is not recommended for patients to fit or apply or adjust their new brace without an orthopedic professional's expertise, unless otherwise instructed. Further questions regarding adjustments or changes, frequency of use, and/or duration of use should be presented to your orthopedic professional, as they are familiar with the specific needs and conditions, for which this device was prescribed.

CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Please do not place your brace in the washing machine or dryer at any time. When preparing to clean your **ISO Preferred Dorsal Night Splint (AN39x)** you will want to separate the parts where applicable and care for them individually.

- Do not dry clean, iron, bleach, or use an abrasive cleaning instrument on any part of the brace. Failure
 to follow these instructions may damage your brace and void the manufacturer's warranty and it may
 no longer work properly.
- Hand wash each section in cold water with a mild detergent. Lay flat to air dry.
- Allow all parts to air dry prior to reassembling the device.
